## Safety/Security:

- Dean Graves, our caretaker, has reported that there is clay from the swim area being smeared all over the garbage cans, picnic tables and inside the girl's bathroom down by The Hut. If anyone has any information about this, please let him know. The suspects definitely do not have adult supervision when visiting that area of the park.
- We have been experiencing a high volume of break-ins here at Paradise Shores. If you see any activity that seems suspicious, please call the <u>Sheriff's office at 350- 275-4467 Ext 313.</u>
- Boats and jet skis are still traveling to fast through the entrance/exit of the marina channel. Please
  observe the "No Wake Zone" as you leave/enter the marina. The marina use is a privilege and not a
  right so the privilege can be revoked. State law mandates that you drive your boat 5mph to the last
  orange marker.
- Your <u>loose dogs</u> are peeing and pooping on your neighbor's property. Please keep them fenced or leashed if outside of your home!
- Please observe the "no glass on the beach" rule.
- The floating dock outside the swim area is for **boats only**. There is no sun bathing or swimming off of this dock.
- Please pick up after yourselves in the park and that includes cigarette butts, bottle caps, etc.!
- Please keep your property free of garbage and junk. We have been noticing a high volume of rats in our neighborhoods. Members who walk regularly (some with leashed dogs) have asked if property owners/tenants could mow along the sides the roads. It would look great and they can avoid walking in the street.
