

Water Committee Report

During the last two months, 60 days (January 5th to March 6th), our well pumps have pumped a total of 879,697 gallons out of the ground. The highest usage was 12,382 cubic feet (92,624 gallons), averaging 1,544 gallons per day.

17 accounts are past due and zero are pending service suspension.

3 properties exceeded their water allotment and only one of them is high usage. A Big thanks to the lots that remained within their allotment. We are allotted 120 Acre Feet (39 million gallons) per year for the entire association. It is incumbent for each member to use water wisely and monitor their usage.

I urge all members to check for leaks, to turn off their water at the meter if they intend to leave for an extended period, and to practice responsible water usage. If you have high usage, please evaluate your plumbing to determine if you may have a leaky toilet, leaks in your lines, or if you may be wasting water because of bad water usage practices.
