

PSA Neighborhood Block Watch Report November 18, 2023

The Neighborhood Block Watch consists of two Co-managers and 11 captains. Most have access to our “private” FB page where we retain records of photos, recordings, and incident reporting. We believe those records may be helpful to the Sheriff’s department in the future.

There has been one incident reported to me since my last report. Here is the narrative:
“A member of our community reported that he encountered two vehicles which were parked in front of another PSA member’s home on Olympic Dr. It was 3:00 am. One vehicle was a blue/black Trailblazer with a license plate BGR XXXX or XXXX. The other was a small tan vehicle with no back window. The vehicles were occupied by drivers. The member said the small vehicle drove away quickly after he had stopped to observe them.” I sent the report to Officer Colbenson. I also asked the officer to ask the Sheriff’s Department to increase their presence in our community during the overnight hours.

While we are keeping track of incidents such as the above and we appreciate you letting us know of the events, I encourage you to also call the Sheriff’s non-emergency number 360.426.4441 and report to them, as well. Our Neighborhood Block Watch reports and your reports to the Sheriff helps keep our community at the top of their mind which may increase their presence in our community.
