<u>Governing Documents Committee News (Tina Simms Chairman):</u> The committee is meeting regularly to revise the PSA Rules/Guidelines. Subjects of discussion include: Requirements for Short Term Rentals and HOA dues collection procedures when delinquent. Hopefully these revisions will be approved by the Board at the January Board meeting for distribution to the members.

<u>Facilities Committee News (Daniel McClough Chairman)</u>: The ski dock has been moved to inside the marina, thanks to Daniel. Seasonal launch fee (\$25), seasonal kayak storage (\$70), and Hut rental (\$25 per day) will remain the same for 2024.

<u>Finance Committee News (Velinda Brown acting Chair):</u> The Finance committee is looking for a new Treasurer. Unfortunately, Eric Fiedler is not able to continue due to work and family commitments. Julie at Belfair Tax, our bookkeeper, continues to provide excellent service at a very reasonable cost.

Marina Committee News: The Loyalty Program was approved by the Board for 2024. The Program runs from February 1 to February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Applications should be submitted to Jan Moon, at 30 E Shore Dr (360-426-1557) or mailed to PSA Marina at 261 E Shore Dr, Grapeview, WA 98546. Any member who rented a slip in 2023 is eligible to rent **one** slip under this program. Moorage fees for 2024 are \$400 (jet ski/single slip) and \$800 (double slip or boats in excess of 16 feet). Daily moorage fees will be \$25 per day. There will be a change in rental for the new Dock C (jet skis only on west side next to the peninsula/boats on east side) but current docks will be in place until mid-September when they will be removed to install the new pilings. The new Docks A & B will be installed in November 2024. Gangways, for the docks, will be installed when docks are completed. The new launch is planned to be completed sometime after July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend. Next marina committee meeting will be held following the January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024 Board meeting at MBCC, 11:30am.

<u>Water System Committee News:</u> The water system committee led by Will James, continues to monitor and manage our water system to ensure compliance and good water usage stewardship.
