

Paradise Shores Estates Park and Marina Rules 2024

Park Rules

- Park is open April 1st to October 31st from 8am-Dusk
- Members and guests **must check in per visit** with the caretakers upon entering the park, you will be asked for member's name and lot number
- Vehicles are to park in designated areas only or as directed, 15 minute limit in load/unload zone, keep speed under 5 mph.
- Children under 12 must be supervised (adult preferred) while in the park
- Load/Unload dock (off main jetty) is for boaters only (no swimming/sun bathing allowed)
- No lifeguard is on duty, swim at your own risk
- No bicycles or pets are allowed past the sports court. Pets are to be on leashes at all times/clean up after them
- No bicycles, roller blades, skateboards, or scooters on the sports court
- Fires are allowed in fire pit (provided) only
- Dumpsters are for park use only. Please use garbage cans located throughout the park
- **Smoking and vapes are allowed in designated area only, east side of park** (a picnic table and ash tray are provided)
- No fireworks are allowed in the park at any time

Marina Rules

- Launch and Marina are for members and their guests only
- Season of operation: April 1-October 31st
- Vehicle gate open from 8am- to dusk (Cruisers returning after dusk should park outside the gate)
- Vessels must have current registration, insurance, moorage form filed with PSA caretaker, and fees paid prior to using the marina (fees include seasonal or daily rates)
- Guests are restricted to daily marina use only. (see caretaker for slip availability and form)
- PSA is not responsible for stolen, lost or damaged property
- PSA and caretakers are NOT responsible, in any way, for vessels in the marina
- Clear the boat launch as quickly as possible
- No power loading of watercraft (boats or jet ski's)
- Clean trailers of weeds before leaving the park
- No Wake Zone: marina to outer white buoy
- No swimming or fishing in the marina
- Do not leave your gas cans or containers on docks or they may be confiscated
- **NO SMOKING OR OPEN FLAME ON MARINA DOCKS**
