## Updates since March 16, 2024

- Events Completed
  - o Polar Plunge:
    - Hung tarp, bonfire, and hut arrangement.
  - Cinco de Mayo
    - Hung tarp, bonfire, hut arrangement, and served food \$140 profit
- Events Scheduled

- Purchases:
  - Battery for Lawn mower.
  - Spark plug for Lawn mower.
  - Paint and painting supplies for bathroom
  - Lights for bathroom
  - Nuts and bolts for ski dock ramp installation
  - 4x6 board for south end of ski dock to replace rotten board.
  - Wind blinds for the west side of the hut
- Reported issues:
  - Key pad for side gate isn't responding very well. Need to investigate to determine cause.
  - Wasp/hornet nests.
- Work completed:
  - Old dock ramps demolished.
  - Park initial setup for the season
    - Pressure washed
    - Moved picnic tables, benches, and chairs
    - Cleaned up park, beach, lawns, and gravel
    - Cleaned marina water ways
  - Ski dock float installed and south end board replaced.
  - Ski dock moved out to lake side for the season.
  - Ski dock old brackets removed and wood installed for new ski dock ramp bracket installation.
  - Bathrooms completed and included the follow in both bathrooms:
    - Partitions
    - Two coats of paint and ceiling and walls
    - New light fixtures
    - Molding around ceiling
    - New step-up deck for caretakers/guest interactions
    - Clean up all debris from remodel
    - Locks on partition doors
  - Normal park lawn maintenance.

    - Spring purchased and went to install, however spring needs to be welded to base plate.

    - Filling in with rocks and stones we currently have. Will need to purchase some gravel to finishing filling in.
  - Wind blinds installation
    - No purchases required. All supplies are on hand

  - Painting the basketball hoops.

  - Painting announcement board

We have made several repairs on our riding lawn mower over these last two years and it is running well, however we are approaching the need to purchase a new one within the next year or two. We have accidently come across a used lawn mower that is in excellent condition for \$1200 dollars. This is a John Deere riding tractor similar to ours with only 41 hours of operations on it.
