

I created a report and sent it to Deputy Matt Colbenson, our contact at Mason County Sheriff’s Office. I sent the digital images and video that Will provided to me to Deputy Colbenson as well.

While we keep track of incidents and we appreciate you letting us know of the events, I encourage our members to call the Sheriff’s non-emergency number 360.426.4441 and report to them, as well. Our Neighborhood Block Watch cumulative reports and your reports to the Sheriff’s Department help keep our community at the top of their minds, which may increase their presence in our community.
