

Water Committee Report

During the last two months, 56 days (January 1st February 26th), our well pumps pumped a total of 683,266 gallons out of the ground.

The highest usage was 3,178 cubic feet (23,773 gallons), averaging 424 gallons per day.

Zero accounts exceeded their allotment. Thank you to everyone for wise water management. 26 accounts are past due, and two are pending service suspension. One account is suspended.

Our five water system reserve CDs have gained \$3,684.20 for the months of January and February.

Members are urged to turn off their water at the meter if they intend to leave for an extended period. Turning off your water will help prevent leaks and thousands of dollars in water charges and possible costly repairs.
