Membership 2024-2025: Since the 2024 through 2025 Annual Membership Meetings, there have been seven completed transfers of property ownership within the PSA Community.

Public Relations: The Citizens Auxiliary Advisory Meetings hosted by Sheriff Spurling occurs at the Spencer Lake Bar and Grill at 8:30 a.m. on the first Thursday of each month and at the Boat House Restaurant located in Allyn the second Thursday of each month at 11:30 a.m.

Typical reporting subjects are about multiple safety issues, public affairs, guest speakers from Mason County, State Patrol Officers, Fire Department Reps and Health Department officials. So, the continuation of inflatable "boats" for sleeping on the open room floor and continued transporting of arrested individuals to other jails in the other counties that have room will occur. This process is at a huge expense to residents of Mason County for their housing, medical, food, and renting of jail space plus transportation there and back.

A very huge, huge, disappointment!!
