

PSA Neighborhood Block Watch Report
PSA Board Meeting at the Hut
Sept 21, 2025

The Neighborhood Block Watch consists of two Co-managers and 11 captains. Most have access to our "private" FB page where we retain records of photos, recordings, and incident reporting. We believe those records may be helpful to the Sheriff's department in the future.

There have been several incidents since my last report. In early August, a concerned neighbor told me there is concern about a member of our community who may be dealing drugs. They live near the corner of Mason Lake Dr E and Olympic Dr. The concerned neighbor said his wife drives by late at night on her way home and often sees a "red light" in the yard and a line of cars outside the residence. In addition, two community members have experienced gasoline theft from their vehicles (and a boat) within the last month. These issues have been reported to our Sheriff Office contact.

While we keep track of incidents and appreciate our members for letting us know of the incidents, I encourage our members to call the Sheriff's non-emergency number 360.426.4441 and report to them, as well. Our Neighborhood Block Watch cumulative reports and your individual reporting to the Sheriff's Department help keep our community at the top of their minds, which may increase their presence in our community.
