

Water Committee Report

During the last two months, 63 days (October 30th to January 1st), our well pumps pumped a total of 7,94,253 gallons out of the ground.

One account exceeded their allotment. Usage was 32,165 cubic feet (240,611 gallons), averaging 3,819 gallons per day.

18 accounts are past due, and two are pending service suspension. Two accounts are suspended.

Our five water system reserve CDs have gained an additional \$3,677.10 for the months of November and December. These CDs matured on December 28, 2025, earning a total of \$22,912. These 5 CDs have automatically renewed for another year at 3.5% interest.

Members are urged to turn off their water at the meter if they intend to leave for an extended period. Turning off your water will help prevent leaks and thousands of dollars in water charges and possible costly repairs.

I encourage people to contact myself or NorthWest Water if they experience any water system problems.

We have not had water system issues for the last two months

I have received results from the evaluation of our booster pumps.

I still plan to have a committee meeting, probably in February, to evaluate systems expenditures and revenue totals, and any necessity to raise rates in the future to maintain the water system financially in the black. Meeting specifics TBD.
