

Water Committee Report

During the last two months, 54 days (January 1st to February 24th), our well pumps pumped a total of 8,622,246 gallons out of the ground.

One account exceeded their allotment. Usage was 4,161 cubic feet (31,126 gallons), averaging 576 gallons per day.

12 accounts are past due, and two are pending service suspension. Two accounts are suspended. Total outstanding amount is \$3589.18.

Our five water system reserve CDs have gained an additional \$3,648.75 for the last three days of December, and the months of January and February.

Members are urged to turn off their water at the meter if they intend to leave for an extended period. Turning off your water will help prevent leaks and thousands of dollars in water charges and possible costly repairs.

I encourage people to contact myself or NorthWest Water if they experience any water system problems.

We have not had water system issues for the last two months

I plan to have a committee meeting in April, to evaluate systems expenditures and revenue totals, and any necessity to raise rates in the future to maintain the water system financially in the black. I am currently compiling historical information for expenditures for the last couple of years to properly present the financial trends. Meeting specifics TBD.
