

Annual Facilities Report 2026
July 11, 2026

Updates since July 12, 2025

A) There were a couple tasks that were completed over the winter prior to the park opening:

- 1) Otter holes were dug up and filled with rock, covered with soil and seeded
- 2) We had a good work party to get the park ready for opening at the end of March that included raking of the beach, raking the rock around the hut, pulling weeds, taking the ski dock out, putting out the tables, organizing the hut making sure the facility was ready for the season.

B) Previous Park caretakers, Jerry and Sue finished out the 2025 year with their standard duties and closed up/winterized the park at the end of October, and were gone for most of the winter. They informed us in March 2026 that they decided they were moving on. They were gone by the end of that month. They had been here since August of 2022.

1) After a few applicants and interviews, the new caretakers, Ron and Erica Tisdale were chosen to fill the spot. They have been a good fit.

2) Ron has been working hard on keeping the park in good shape as well as adding some needed projects to his list of duties:

He has done normal park lawn maintenance, restroom cleaning, welding on the play equipment, painting the bathroom building having the hut clean and ready for rentals, lots of weeding the landscape, organizing the sheds, pressure washed the court, etc.... He will be moving on to painting the hut as time allows.

He and Erica have also been scheduling hut usage, taking launch fees and making sure the proper people are using the park and facilities.

C) There are a couple things that need to be addressed:

1) The hut is not for storage of water play equipment or anything else that is not the property of the park. The issue is that when someone is scheduled to use the hut and there are items stored there that don't belong, they need to be moved out, and we cannot be responsible if something is stolen or blows away. It is not the caretakers' job to keep track of peoples personal items. Please take your park/water items with you when you leave, unless you are paying for and have a rackable item.

2) Please make sure if you have guests on your list, that when you fill out a guest slip, you bring your guests to meet the caretakers. This will help them remember who they are letting into the park and will be less of a hassle for your guests. This is also a requirement.
